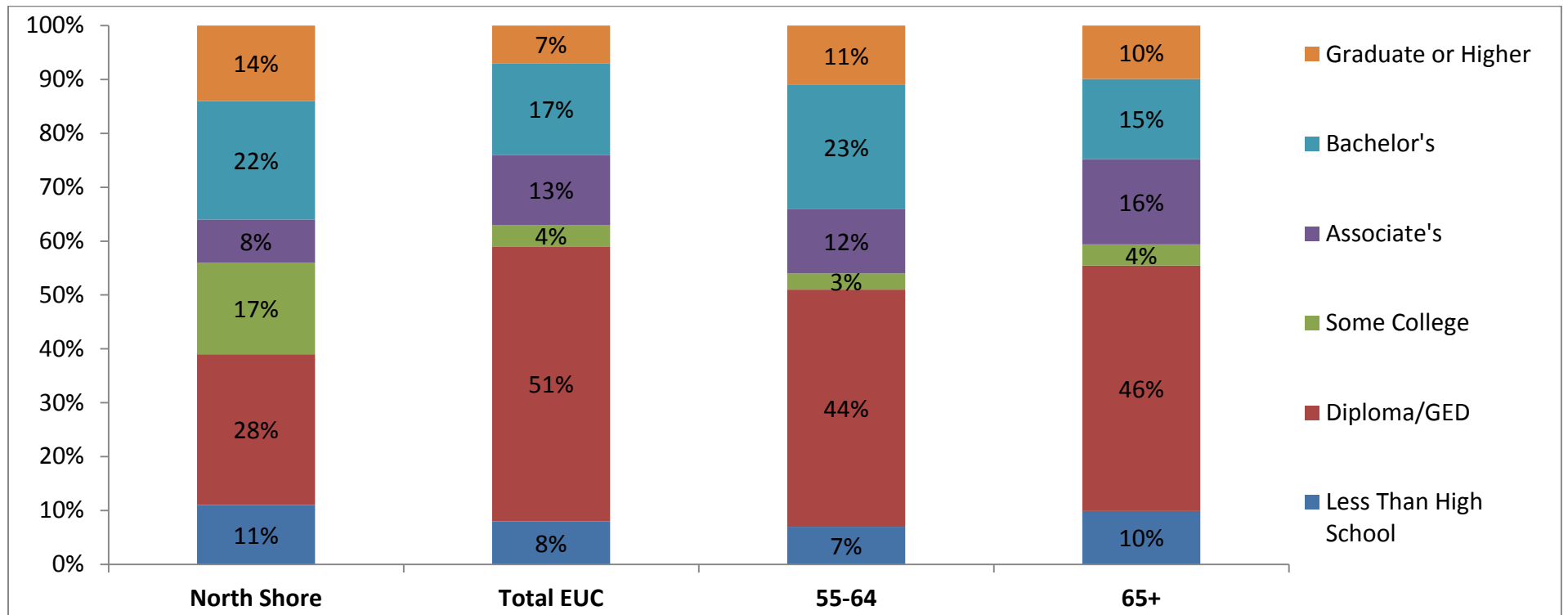


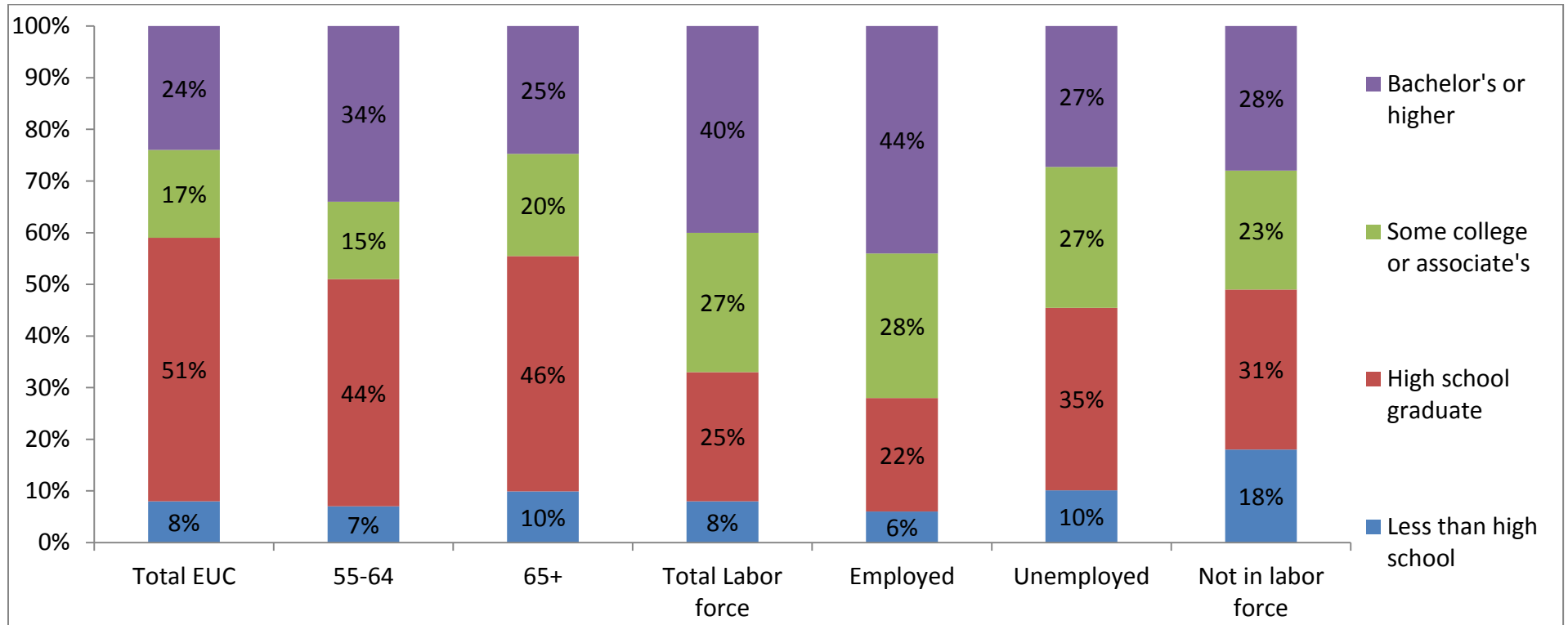

- Both the 55-64 and 65+ have educational attainments higher than the Total EUC Cohort.
- The EUC 55-64 has a lower post-secondary educational attainment than the North Shore Population but a higher rate of Associate's and Bachelor's.
- The EUC 65+ has lower post-secondary educational attainment than the North Shore population but a higher rate of Associate's.

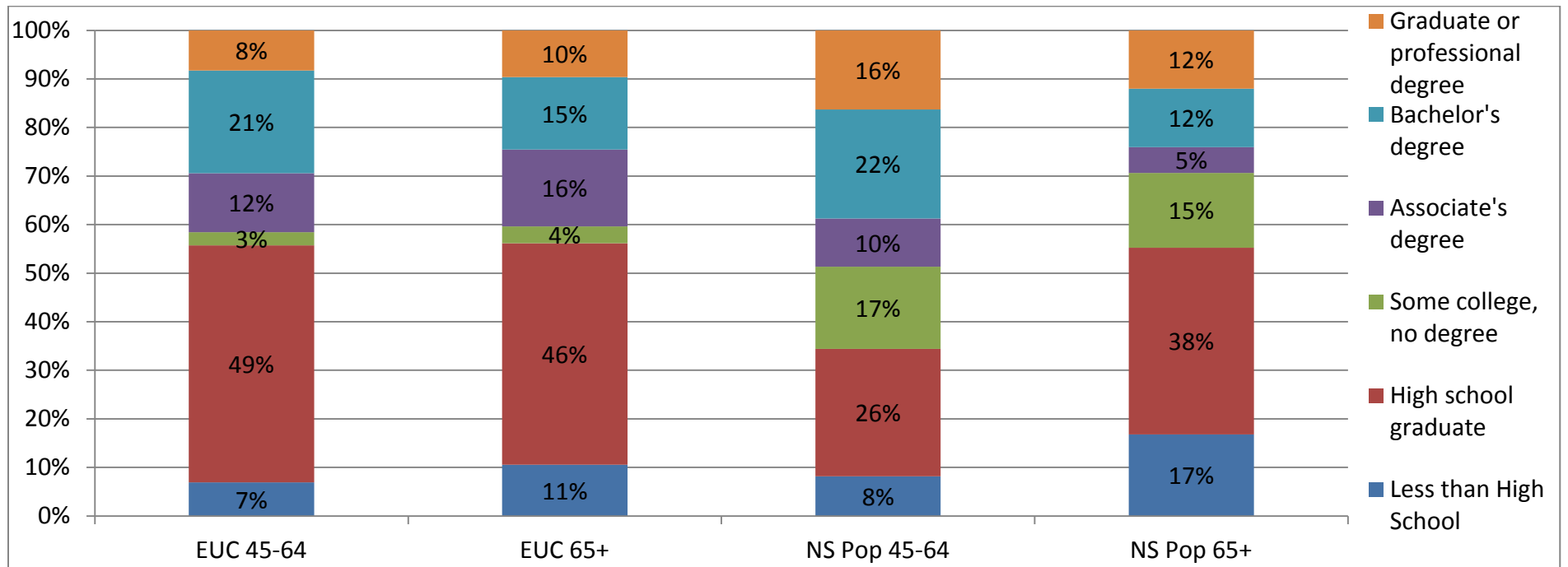

- The EUC Cohorts all have post-secondary educational attainment levels significantly lower than the employed North Shore population.
  - 31% difference between the overall EUC Cohort (41%) and Employed Population (72%)
  - 23% difference between the 55-64 EUC Cohort (49%) and Employed Population (72%)
  - 27% difference between the 65+ EUC Cohort (45%) and Employed Population (72%)

- The EUC 45-64 Cohort has an overall lower post-secondary educational attainment compared to the North Shore population but a similar level of Bachelor's degree attainment.
  - This group has a slightly higher level of Associate's degree attainment.
- The EUC 65+ has a similar level of Educational attainment compared to the North Shore population but differences lie in the educational breakdown.
  - The EUC 65+ has higher levels of Bachelor's and Associate's degrees but lower levels of Graduate and Some College.
